The top 5 results will be counted for each club.</p>	

	<p>Champion Senior Club – Perpetual Trophy for the Club with highest combined Senior point score on the Day.</p> <p>Champion Club - Perpetual Trophy for the Club with highest combined point score on the Day. The point score will be based on the top 5 results for each club from each class (Junior & Senior)</p> <p>The point scores will be calculated based on the matrix used for the State Cup according to the number of competitors in the class & the position obtained in each of the heats, pre-final and final, based on the points allocation shown below:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 3 heats – 25% - (8.3% each) • Pre-Final – 25% • Final – 50%. <p>Perpetual trophies will be funded equally by the five clubs in the Metro Zone. Other trophies / prizes will be those offered by the host club for that year. Trophies will be awarded to fifth place for Junior Classes and to third place for Senior Classes.</p>

3.1.	Pit Crew with trolleys will not be given access to the Circuit during Qualifying and Racing.
3.2.	Retrieval of Karts is at the discretion of the Clerk of the Course
3.3.	Pit Crew must only enter the Circuit when permitted by the Grid Marshal and then only if wearing a HIGH VISIBILITY SAFETY VEST on the upper torso.
3.4.	Karts can be retrieved via the gates at the end of the top and bottom straight on the direction of an Official.
4.	ADDITIONAL VENUE REQUIREMENTS
4.1.	Subject to any applicable laws which may govern the access of animals, including but not limited to guide dogs, no animals are allowed anywhere within the facility.
4.2.	No dumping of Fuel or Tyres, please make own arrangements.
4.3.	No unlicensed driving of motor vehicles permitted at the Circuit.

4.4.	No motorised scooters, mini bikes, roller blading, skateboards and tricycles allowed at the complex during the entire Meeting. Officials may confiscate any such items for the duration of the Meeting.
