#### 4. CIRCUIT SPECIFIC REQUIREMENTS

<b>4.1</b>	<b>PADDOCK ALLOCATION</b>
a)	Pit space is on a first served basis however, CDKC may reserve spots for club sponsors. If an entrant is asked to move by a CDKC Committee member they are required to do so.
<b>4.2</b>	<b>MEDICAL SERVICES</b>

<b>4.3</b>	<b>KART RETRIEVAL</b>
a)	Pit Crew with trolleys will not be given access to the Circuit during Qualifying and Racing.
b)	Retrieval of karts is at the discretion of the Clerk of the Course
c)	Pit Crew must only enter the Circuit when permitted by the Grid Marshal and then only if wearing a high visibility safety vest on the upper torso.
d)	Karts can be retrieved via
<b>4.4</b>	<b>ADDITIONAL VENUE REQUIREMENTS</b>
a)	No animals allowed anywhere within the facility with the exception of Guide and Special Assisted dogs.
b)	No dumping of Fuel or Tyres anywhere within the track property.
c)	No unlicensed driving of any motor vehicle is permitted at the circuit.
d)	No motorised scooters, mini bikes, roller blades, skateboards or tricycles allowed at the complex during the entire meeting. Officials may confiscate any such items for the duration of the meeting.
e)	Marquees are not to be erected without consent of the Club Committee.
