4.1	PADDOCK ALLOCATION

4.3	KART RETRIEVAL
a)	Pit Crew with trolleys will NOT be given access to the Circuit during Qualifying and Racing.
b)	Retrieval of karts is at the discretion of the Clerk of the Course
c)	Pit Crew must only enter the Circuit when permitted by the Grid Marshal and then only if wearing a high visibility safety vest on the upper torso.
d)	Karts can be retrieved via multiple entry points & exit points as directed by an official.
4.4	ADDITIONAL VENUE REQUIREMENTS
a)	No animals allowed anywhere within the facility with the exception of Guide dogs or Special Assistance dogs.
b)	No dumping of Fuel or Tyres, please make own arrangements.
c)	No unlicensed driving of motor vehicles permitted at the circuit.
d)	No motorised scooters, mini bikes, roller blading, skateboards and tricycles allowed at the complex during the entire meeting. Officials may confiscate any such items for the duration of the Meeting.
e)	Marquees are not to be erected without consent of the Club.
