4.1	PADDOCK ALLOCATION
	a) Pit space is on a first served basis however, CDKC may reserve spots for club sponsors. If an entrant is asked to move by a CDKC Committee member they are required to do so.
4.2	MEDICAL SERVICES
	a) Any Medical assistance that is required outside of the operating hours when Kart's are not on the Race Track please contact 000. The address to give to the Emergency Services is: 137 Oakey Forest Road, Marrangaroo (Lithgow) NSW 2790
4.3	KART RETRIEVAL
	a) Pit Crew with trolleys will not be given access to the Circuit during Qualifying and Racing.
	b) Retrieval of karts is at the discretion of the Clerk of the Course
	c) Pit Crew must only enter the Circuit when permitted by the Grid Marshal and then only if wearing a high visibility safety vest on the upper torso.
	d) Karts can be retrieved via gates at end of the top and bottom straight on the direction of an official.
4.4	ADDITIONAL VENUE REQUIREMENTS
	a) No animals allowed anywhere within the facility.
	b) No dumping of Fuel or Tyres, please make own arrangements.
	c) No unlicensed driving of motor vehicles permitted at the circuit.
	d) No motorised scooters, mini bikes, roller blading, skateboards and tricycles allowed at the complex during the entire Meeting. Officials may confiscate any such items for the duration of the Meeting.
	e) Marquees are not to be erected without consent of the Club.
4.5	ACCOMMODATION FACILITIES
	Camping is available to competitors at Lithgow City Raceway at a fee of \$20.00 per site per day. The camping area is located along the top straight of the circuit. Before setting up your camping site please go to the Race Secretaries office to make your payment where you will be issued with a receipt. Some powered sites are available. Please note this area is for personal camping only. Race competition 'pitting' of karts is not permitted.
