

Level Crossing Works Oakley Forest Road, Marrangaroo January 2016

Improving the Country Rail Network

Transport for New South Wales (TfNSW) is undertaking rail maintenance works in Marrangaroo as part of the NSW Government's rail infrastructure program across the country rail network.

Works are being completed by TfNSW's contractor, John Holland Rail (JHR). JHR operate and maintain the Country Regional Network across NSW under a ten year contract with TfNSW.



Level crossing works

As part of the rail maintenance works, the existing level crossing at Oakley Forest Road, Marrangaroo, requires reconditioning.

Works involve

- Site establishment and material delivery.
- Reconditioning of the existing crossing; and
- Site de-mobilization and restoration.

When will work commence?

Site operations will run from 7:00am on Saturday 30 January, to 6:00pm Sunday 31 January 2016.

How will I be impacted?

During the works period the level crossing will be closed to all traffic. A temporary level crossing will be put in place on the western side of the Oakley Forest Road level crossing with Traffic Management in place. Local residents and businesses may experience short delays.

Residents may experience some noise and extra vehicle movements associated with this work, however we will endeavour to minimize disruption wherever possible.
