E. MEETING CONDITIONS

CONTROL FUEL:

Control Fuel will be used at this meeting. Fuel (Supreme 98) must be purchased from

7 Eleven Lithgow, 1131 Great Western Highway,

South Bowenfells (next to McDonald's).

Control Fuel can be purchased from Thursday September 28th, 2023. Receipt to be produced if requested.

SEALS & TAGS:

Each engine must be sealed, and each chassis must be tagged, in accordance with the Technical Regulations T.7.1. Chassis tags must be fitted to the chassis inside the right stub axle mount (the tag and tail must not be cut). Engines must have drilled nuts as required for each specific engine/class (excess cable may be cut once engine is sealed) Distribution will be advised in timetable.

TRANSPONDERS:

Compatible timing transponders must be fitted in accordance with the Technical Regulations T.3.14, **for all Practice, Qualifying, Heats and Finals.**

TYRES:

Practice tyres are not subject to tyre pooling and there is no limit on tyres used in practice

For competition, Tyre pooling will be used in all classes at this meeting for slick tyres. Competitors are required to purchase their dry weather tyres from the "tyre pool" on Friday October 29. The tyre pool will be controlled by Maxxis Tyres distributor (**St George Karts**) and the meeting scrutineers.

Class collection times to be advised in event timetable. Wet scrutineer times will be advised (Competitors are to supply their own wet tyres)

In extraordinary circumstances as decided at the absolute discretion of the Chief Scrutineer a driver may be permitted to receive a second replacement tyre in accordance with Rule T.5.5.



NOSECONES:

Must use the CIK-FIA Drop Down homologated Nose Cone mounting kit, per Technical Regulations T.2.9. Karts must be presented to out grid with nose cone removed for inspection for all races.

CAMERAS:

A forward-facing camera is mandatory **ON ALL KARTS** and shall be operational for all racing, qualifying and practice. Stewards must be supplied video upon request from any competitor. Failure to provide video footage may result in a penalty. Cameras are to be fitted in accordance with Technical Regulations T.3.16. Additional cameras, including rear facing camera are optional and encouraged.

PIT ALLOCATION:

Each competitor will be allocated a pit space 5m x 7m. There is a limited number of 5m x14m sites at the lower end of the pit and powered Caravan sites that you can pit from available to be booked in "other products" when you enter. If you wish to pit in a team or group, please add the team or group name to you sponsors on your entry details. It will be helpful if a member of the team/group can advise details early and ideally have the group all enter at a similar time. It is strongly recommended that group/teams get this organised early. All pit equipment must fit in the allocated space, any excess is to be removed from the pit area. Pit space location priority will be given to entries as received. Pit allocation and use will be deemed an official instruction for the meeting. All vehicles are to be removed from the pit area unless approved by the organisers. There will be an area outside the pits available for larger vehicles, please contact us to request this so we do not allocate a space inside the pit area.

F. CLUB/TRACK REQUIREMENTS

MEDICAL SERVICES:

RACETRACK ENTRY:

Once Karts start moving and the out-grid gate(s) are closed, there will be no further entry of Karts, persons or equipment to the Racetrack, until the completion of practice/racing and all Karts are stopped.

KART RETRIEVAL:

Retrieval of Karts is at the discretion of the Clerk of Course.

Pit Crew must only enter the Race Track area when permitted by the Grid Marshall or Clerk of Course, and then only if wearing a HIGH VISIBILITY Safety Vest or Clothing on the upper torso.

ANIMALS:

Subject to the applicable laws which may govern the access of animals, no animals are allowed anywhere within the Track precinct, other than Registered Service Dogs.



OTHER:

Please drive **slowly and quietly** entering the track on Oakey Forest Road.

Track is available for practice via electronic sign-on and separate payment www.cdkc.com.au up to Sunday the 24th of September 2023. Private practice days are 9:00am to 4:00pm

No Kart engine starts any day before 8:00am or during Drivers Briefing.

Overnight camping is permitted on the grounds along the main straight area, \$5.00 per night per person, payable with your entry under "other products".

There are a limited number of reserved powered van sites. \$100.00 per site for Thursday to Sunday. These can be booked with your entry under "other products".

There are a limited number of power outlets in the pits, with a limited amount of power available. High use electrical items will overload the circuit, causing the power to shut off for all.

No Generators after 10:00pm

No dumping of Fuel or Tyres, please make your own arrangements.

No unlicensed driving of motor vehicles permitted at the Track.

Please keep the Ambulance gate/entrance always clear.

Canteen will be available Friday to Sunday.


