F. CLUB/TRACK REQUIREMENTS

MEDICAL SERVICES:

Any Medical assistance that is required outside of the operating hours when Karts are not on the Race Track please contact 000. The address to give to the Emergency Services is:
Lithgow City Raceway, 137 Oakey Forest Road, Marrangaroo. NSW 2790.

RACETRACK ENTRY:

Once Karts start moving and the out-grid gate(s) are closed, there will be no further entry of Karts, persons or equipment to the Racetrack, until the completion of practice/racing and all Karts are stopped.

KART RETRIEVAL:

Retrieval of Karts is at the discretion of the Clerk of Course.

Pit Crew must only enter the Racetrack area when permitted by the Grid Marshall or Clerk of Course, and then only if wearing a HIGH VISIBILITY Safety Vest or Clothing on the upper torso.

ANIMALS:

Subject to the applicable laws which may govern the access of animals, no animals are allowed anywhere within the Track precinct, other than Registered Service Dogs.

OTHER:

- Please drive **slowly and quietly** entering the track on Oakey Forest Road.
- Track is available for practice via electronic sign-on and separate payment www.cdkc.com.au Friday and Saturday prior to race day. **Race transponder & numbers must be fitted Saturday, sign on required by 8.00am.** \$20.00 surcharge after 8.00am.
- Saturday practice will be controlled from the timing box, Race control lights will be operating, the practice official will be in the timing box.
- Qualifying start grid may be adjusted for any non-compliance of practice rules.
- Pit spaces must be pre booked with your entry (other products) and will be allocated as entry is received. All your equipment must fit within the allocated bay, other vehicles and equipment are to be removed from the pit area. Reserved pit bays will be numbered, a list of bookings will be posted on CDKC media and the notice board. No changes will be made to allocated pit bays. Pitting outside your allocated space may result in race penalties. If you wish to pit in a team or group, please add this to your entry sponsors.
- Entry lists will be posted on the club's media channels, **Check your entry details.** If you need to request any changes to entry details the **cut off time is 4.00pm Saturday.** No Changes will be made Sunday morning.
- Overnight camping Is permitted on the grounds. Setting up in the 'Camping area' is preferred. Camping fee is \$5.00 per person per night (please pay with your entry) Powered sites are available \$50.00 per site, must be booked with your entry.
- No Generators after 10.00pm. Power supply in the pits is VERY limited, do not plug in high use items.
