## **Minimum Entries:**







If fewer than 10 entries are received at the close of entries, that class may not be run. If the class is not to be run, competitors will be notified by July 30th entry fee & tyre fee will be refunded.

If fewer than 20 entries are received the prize pool for that class may be reduced by 50%.

#### **Maximum Entries:**

Each class will be capped at 32 entries for all classes other than TAG Light. TAG Light entries will be capped at 64 entries.

#### **CONTROL FUEL:**

Control Fuel will be used in this series. Control Fuel (Supreme 98) must be purchased from 7-Eleven Lithgow, 1131 Great Western Highway, South Bowenfells. Control Fuel can be purchased after Wednesday July  $30^{\rm th}$ . Receipt must be retained and be produced if requested.

#### **ENGINE SEALING:**







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Each engine must be sealed in accordance with the Technical Regulations. Distribution will be advised in the event timetable. If a competitor damages or incorrectly fits a seal and requires it to be replaced the cost of the additional seal will be \$10.

#### **TRANSPONDERS:**

Compatible timing transponders must be fitted in accordance with the Technical Regulations T.3.14, **for all Practice, Qualifying and Racing.** 

#### **TYRES:**

Tyre pooling will be used in all feature classes for Dry tyres.

Competitors are required to purchase their dry weather tyres from the "tyre pool".

(Payment is made with race entry) The tyre pool will be controlled by CDKC.

Class collection times to be advised in the event timetable.

Competitors are to supply their own wet tyres

Wet tyres and practice dry tyres may also be purchased at the time of entry (listed under "other products") and will be available to collect at the track Friday August 22nd from 8.00am

TAG Restricted, KZ2 and 4SS are to supply their own tyres, these may be purchased with entry up to July 29th.

#### **CCTV Video review**

If an on track issue has occurred that the officials have not instigated action on and you wish us to review the circuit footage, you will be required to lodge a completed protest form and pay the protest fee via the CDKC website <a href="https://www.cdkc.com.au/about-us/payments/">https://www.cdkc.com.au/about-us/payments/</a>. The information on the protest form must include the time & location the incident occurred & the number of any other karts involved. After review of the footage, if officials determine an obvious breach of the rules and, take action based on this, your protest fee will be refunded. If the officials do not determine and obvious breach based on the Circuit footage your protest will be forwarded to the event Stewards and take the normal course of action.

#### Full Course Yellow/Safety Car:

If officials need to slow and compress the field due to an on-track incident, a "Full Course Yellow and Virtual Safety car" will be used. When this is in operation all flag points will show flashing yellow lights (or waved yellow flags in the event of light failure). The race control board (at the finish line) will show "Safety Car" and show the number of the lead kart. The race start lights will also be changed to Yellow. When any flashing yellow lights or the Safety Car symbol are shown all Karts must safely and immediately slow to less than 20 KMPH and maintain position. All karts will line up behind the lead kart (being allowed to safely increase speed to catch the lead karts) in single file. Once the incident is cleared, the flashing yellow lights and safety car symbol will be extinguished. All karts will remain in single file and at the reduced speed, once the karts have reached the main straight all karts must stay in single file and stay inside the tram track on the outside line. Once the start light is extinguished the lead kart may accelerate and the race is resumed. All karts must stay inside the tram tracks until the start line.

## F. CLUB/TRACK REQUIREMENTS

#### **MEDICAL SERVICES:**

#### **RACETRACK ENTRY:**







Once Karts start moving and the out-grid gate(s) are closed, there will be no further entry of Karts, persons or equipment to the Racetrack, until the completion of practice/racing and all Karts are stopped.

#### **KART RETRIEVAL:**

Retrieval of Karts is at the discretion of the Clerk of Course.

Pit Crew must only enter the Racetrack area when permitted by the Grid Marshall or Clerk of Course, and then only if wearing a HIGH VISIBILITY Safety Vest or Clothing on the upper torso.

#### ANIMALS:

Subject to the applicable laws which may govern the access of animals, no animals are allowed anywhere within the Track precinct, other than Registered Service Dogs.

#### OTHER:

- Please drive **slowly and quietly** entering the track on Oakey Forest Road.
- Track is available for practice via electronic sign-on and separate payment <u>www.cdkc.com.au</u> Friday prior to race day. Race transponder & numbers must be fitted. Sign required by 8.00am (practice fee increases after 8.00am).
- Qualifying start grid may be adjusted for any non-compliance of practice rules.
- Pit spaces must be pre booked with your entry (other products) and will be allocated as entry is received. All your equipment must fit within the allocated bay, other vehicles and equipment are to be removed from the pit area. Reserved pit bays will be numbered, a list of bookings will be posted on CDKC media and the notice board. No changes will be made to allocated pit bays. Pitting or having equipment outside your allocated space may result in race penalties. If you wish to pit in a team or group, please add this to your entry sponsors.
- Entry lists will be posted on the club's media channels, Check your entry details.
   If you need to request any changes to entry details the cut off time is 4.00pm
   Thursday.
- Overnight camping Is permitted on the grounds. Setting up in the 'Camping area" is preferred. Camping fee is \$5.00 per person per night (please pay with your entry) Powered sites are available \$50.00 per site, must be booked with your entry.
- No Generators after 10.00pm. Power supply in the pits is VERY limited, do not plug in high use items.
- No dumping of Fuel or Tyres, please make your own arrangements.
- No unlicensed driving of motor vehicles permitted at the Track.
- No Kart engine starts any day before 8.00am.
