Finishing Position Points:

- ☒ 32 down system (32, 30, 29, 28, 27, 26, 25, 24, 23, 22, 21 etc)  
DNF will receive 0 points, DNS will receive 0 points,  
DSQ will receive 0 points.

**50 LAP CLASSIC DETAIL:**

The 50 Lap Classic will take place after the finals of class racing. The race entry is available to all Junior drivers that have entered the race meeting. Karts for the 50 Lap Classic must conform to Junior Light or Junior Heavy specification. **The first 32 entries will be accepted.** Grid order will be fastest class karts to the front, each class will be gridded in reverse order of the class final for that class. Tyres must be the same used for class racing on the day.

Each class will be given a time handicap that is based on recent lap records at Lithgow City Raceway. The first kart to complete 50 laps will receive the Chequered flag. The race placings will be determined based on the finishing order and handicaps for each class.

**TROPHIES & PRIZES:**

Trophies/awards will be determined by Final Only counts.

Trophies will be awarded for EVERY class (not group) that meets the entry numbers club policy below.

- Junior, Novice and Rookie classes. 7 or more entries, 1st to 5<sup>th</sup>. 6 entries 1st to 4th
- All Classes. 5 entries 1st to 3<sup>rd</sup>. 4 entries 1st and 2<sup>nd</sup>. 3 entries 1<sup>st</sup>. 2 or less entries, no Trophies awarded.

Other prizes and awards may also be presented at the discretion of the Club/Organiser.

### **MEDICAL SERVICES:**

### **RACETRACK ENTRY:**

Once Karts start moving and the out-grid gate(s) are closed, there will be no further entry of Karts, persons or equipment to the Racetrack, until the completion of practice/racing and all Karts are stopped.

### **KART RETRIEVAL:**

Retrieval of Karts is at the discretion of the Clerk of Course.

Pit Crew must only enter the Racetrack area when permitted by the Grid Marshall or Clerk of Course, and then only if wearing a HIGH VISIBILITY Safety Vest or Clothing on the upper torso.

### **ANIMALS:**

Subject to the applicable laws which may govern the access of animals, no animals are allowed anywhere within the Track precinct, other than Registered Service Dogs.

### **OTHER:**

- Please drive **slowly and quietly** entering the track on Oakey Forest Road.
- Track is available for practice via electronic sign-on and separate payment [www.cdkc.com.au](http://www.cdkc.com.au) Friday and Saturday prior to race day. **Race transponder & numbers must be fitted Saturday, sign on required by 8.00am.** \$20.00 surcharge after 8.00am.
- Saturday practice will be controlled from the timing box, Race control lights will be operating, the practice official will be in the timing box.
- Qualifying start grid may be adjusted for any non-compliance of practice rules.
- Pit spaces must be pre booked with your entry (other products) and will be allocated as entry is received. All your equipment must fit within the allocated bay, other vehicles and equipment are to be removed from the pit area. Reserved pit bays will be numbered, a list of bookings will be posted on CDKC media and the notice board. No changes will be made to allocated pit bays. Pitting outside your allocated space may result in race penalties. If you wish to pit in a team or group, please add this to your entry sponsors.
- Entry lists will be posted on the club's media channels, **Check your entry details.** If you need to request any changes to entry details the **cut off time is 1.00pm Saturday.** No Changes will be made Sunday morning.

- Overnight camping Is permitted on the grounds. Setting up in the 'Camping area" is preferred. Camping fee is \$5.00 per person per night (please pay with your entry) Powered sites are available \$50.00 per site, must be booked with your entry.
- No Generators after 10.00pm. Power supply in the pits is VERY limited, do not plug in high use items.
- No dumping of Fuel or Tyres, please make your own arrangements.
- No unlicensed driving of motor vehicles permitted at the Track.
- Bikes and scooters are not permitted in the venue.
- No Kart engine starts any day before 8.00am.
- OLT's are available Saturday contact the club to book you place.
