In instances of a tie-on laps, the Driver with the best position the lap prior (or grid position should no laps be completed) will be awarded the higher points.

Any driver excluded from a race will be awarded the lowest points available for the class (based on the number of entries) minus 1 point.

Round Trophies will be awarded on finishing position of the final for 1st, 2nd, & 3rd in each class and will be the responsibility of the Host Club.

E. MEETING CONDITIONS

CONTROL FUEL:

Control Fuel will be used at this meeting. Fuel Premium 98 ULP must be purchased from BP Lithgow. 325 Main Street, Lithgow. Control Fuel can be purchased from Thursday 29th October 2026. Receipt to be produced if requested.

ENGINE SEALING:

Engines and restrictors (where applicable) will be sealed. Your engine must have nuts/bolts drilled in accordance with the KNSW requirements ready to accept the sealing tags. Engines that are factory sealed (4SS) may use the factory seals at the discretion of the organiser. The event schedule will advise times.

Tyre Scanning:

Race tyres will be scanned. It is preferred that you have both your dry tyres and wet tyres presented for original scanning at the same time. The event schedule will advise times. Please allow extra time to get onto the out grid for qualifying and races. If you are at the track Friday, your race tyres must be presented for scanning Friday. If you are not at the track Friday, your tyres must be presented for scanning prior to the completion of Saturday Practice 1. 1 set of dry tyres and 1 set of wet tyres may be scanned.

F. CLUB/TRACK REQUIREMENTS

MEDICAL SERVICES:

Any Medical assistance that is required outside of the operating hours when Karts are not on the Race Track please contact 000. The address to give to the Emergency Services is:

RACETRACK ENTRY:

Once Karts start moving and the out-grid gate(s) are closed, there will be no further entry of Karts, persons or equipment to the Racetrack, until the completion of practice/racing and all Karts are stopped.

KART RETRIEVAL:

Retrieval of Karts is at the discretion of the Clerk of Course.

Pit Crew must only enter the Racetrack area when permitted by the Grid Marshall or Clerk of Course, and then only if wearing a HIGH VISIBILITY Safety Vest or Clothing on the upper torso.

ANIMALS:

Subject to the applicable laws which may govern the access of animals, no animals are allowed anywhere within the Track precinct, other than Registered Service Dogs.

OTHER:

- Track is available for practice via KNSW portal for Friday prior to racing commencement. Transponder and race number must be fitted. Booking practice via the portal is required before 8.00am on this day. The fee will increase after 8.00am.
- Qualifying start grid may be adjusted for any non-compliance of practice rules.
- Pit spaces will be allocated and published after the close of entries, your equipment must fit within your pit space.
- Entry lists will be posted on the club's media channels, **Check your entry details.** Please check you kart details match the entry list (transponder, race number and class)
- Dinner will be available in the Club House on Saturday Night, book directly with the Canteen.
- Overnight camping Is permitted on the grounds.
- No Generators after 10.00pm.
- No dumping of Fuel or Tyres or Waste, please make your own arrangements.
- No unlicensed driving of motor vehicles permitted at the Track. Scooter's and bikes are not to be used 8.00am to 4.00pm
- No Kart engine starts any day before (8.00am.)
